Warrior Run Borough received a Notice of Payment, from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in the amount of \$104.24 to be paid on June 1, 2026, for State Police Fines and Penalties paid in the first half of 2026.

On 05/20/2026, Warrior Run Borough was notified via email communication the Borough was awarded \$50,000, from the Local Share Account (LSA) Luzerne County Program, for the Upper Beaumont Street Improvements Project grant. Warrior Run Borough submitted a request for \$198,000.00 in September 2025 for this project.

On 05/27/2026, Warrior Run Borough received an email communication from the Luzerne County Office of Community Development regarding applications are due by September 11, 2026, for consideration of inclusion in the County’s 2027 Action Plan. Based on the municipal maps provided with the application, Warrior Run Borough is eligible based on the low to moderate income guidelines.

On 06/03/2026, Warrior Run Borough received an email communication between PennEastern Engineers LLC and RLE Enterprises regarding completion of the Chestnut Street project. RLE indicated Stafursky’s Paving is anticipating to be at the project site the week of 06/15/2026; this will be confirmed with PennEastern Engineers LLC so an inspector is at the project site.
