#### **Attorney Aregood Topics:**

- 1. Attorney Aregood stated that the deed for the ballfield has been executed by The Nature Conservancy, for transfer to Warrior Run Borough. The deed needs to be signed by Council President Larry Carbohn.
- 2. The new Borough Ordinance regarding the new maximum penalties of \$300 to \$500 for borough code violations has been advertised in both local newspaper. Signatures from Borough's official are needed to finalize the ordinance.
- 3. Attorney Aregood has filed four sewer liens with the Prothonotary's office regarding Borough's residents.
- 4. There has been a hearing at Magistrate Halesey's office regarding the Steve Tomcho property at 538-540 Orchard Street. The conclusion was that the property would either be repaired or torn down by a neighbor, who is interested in the property. The expectation is that there would be a settlement of this issue.

- 5. Attorney Aregood was contacted by Atty. Joseph Romano from the Philadelphia area. Atty. Romano is from a large firm that adjudicates personal liability lawsuits. Attorney Romano is currently representing the Cross family in a liability suit with potentially a significant sum of money being awarded to the Cross family. Currently there are two Borough's properties in the Cross family, which have delinquent property taxes. Atty. Aregood stated that Atty. Romano asked if the payments of the taxes be delayed until the resolution of the Cross family suit, which would allow the Cross family to pay the back taxes on 506 Front Street and 361 Hanover Street. Atty. Aregood informed Atty. Romano and Council that the majority of the property taxes on these properties would be owed to the county and school district. Ultimately, the collection agency for delinquent property taxes, Elite Revenue, would have to make the decision about the payment of these delinquent propert taxes.
- 6. Atty. Aregood recommended that the Borough not agree to defer property tax payments on the above mentioned properties, because this could set a precedent for the Borough in similar future tax matters.
- 7. A hearing for the Herbert Wooten properties has been rescheduled by Magistrate's Halesey's office.
