

Minutes of the Reorganization Meeting
of January 2, 2018

The Warrior Run Reorganization Council Meeting of 01/02/1018 was held at the Warrior Run Borough building, Front and Hanover Streets, Warrior Run, PA.

Mayor Tom Shypulefski called for a Reorganization Meeting. The meeting was opened by The Pledge of Allegiance.

Larry Carbohn made a motion to nominate Rick Kratz as Pro-Tem of Council, seconded by Matt Pilch, and passed by 5 yes.

Larry Carbohn made a motion to nominate Thomas Kneidinger as the Secretary/Treasurer, seconded by Matt Pilch, and passed by 5 yes.

Larry Carbohn made a motion to nominate Attorney Patrick Aregood as the Borough Solicitor, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.

Rick Kratz made a motion to nominate Karen Hazleton, CPA as Borough Auditor, seconded by Larry Carbohn and passed by 5 yes.

Larry Carbohn made a motion to nominate John Quinn as Director of Public Works, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.

There was no motion to appoint a Consulting Engineer and Surveyors for the Borough.

Larry Carbohn made a motion to nominate Greg Gulick as the Borough's Code Enforcement Officer. There was no second on the motion.

Larry Carbohn made a motion to hire Michelle O'Brien, Theresa Owens and Rebecca Levandosky as School Crossing Guards, seconded by Matt Pilch, and passed by 5 yes.

Rick Kratz made a motion to elect Citizens' Bank as the Borough's bank depository, seconded by Larry Carbohn, and passed by 5 yes.

Larry Carbohn made a motion to add Rick Kratz as a co-signer on Borough checks, seconded by Larry Carbohn, and passed by 5 yes.

A motion was made by Larry Carbohn to approve council meeting dates as the second Monday of the month, and work sessions at the first Monday of the month, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.

A motion to adjourn was made by Larry Carbohn, seconded by Matt Pilch, and passed by 5 yes.
