A motion was made by Rick Kratz to nominate Karen M. Hazleton, CPA as Borough Auditor, seconded by Matt Pilch, and passed by 5 yes.

A motion was made by Rick Kratz to nominate John Quinn as Director of Public works, seconded by Matt Pilch, and passed by 4 yes. John Quinn abstained from the motion.

A motion was made by Rick Kratz to appoint PennEastern Engineers as Consulting Engineers, seconded by John Quinn, and passed by 5 yes.

A motion was made by John Quinn to appoint Greg Gulick as Code Enforcement Officer, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.

A motion was made by John Quinn to appoint Donna Willis and Ashley Brandolino as School Crossing Guards, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.
