

## Minutes of the Warrior Run Council Meeting

May 8, 2017

The Warrior Run Council Meeting of 05/08/2017 was held at the Warrior Run Borough Building, Front and Hanover Streets, Warrior Run, PA.

The meeting was called to order by Luke Matthews, who also led The Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call: Rick Kratz, Larry Carbohn, Sandra Wegrzynowicz, and Matt Pilch.

The Minutes of the Council Meeting of 04/10/2017 were read by Thomas Kneidinger. The Treasurer's Report from 04/11/2017 to 05/08/2017 was given.

A motion to accept the Minutes of the previous Council Meeting and the current Treasurer's Report was made by Larry Carbohn, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.

COMMUNICATIONS: None.

JONAS KREITZER COUNTY WASTE, LLC: Jonas Kreitzer replaced Scott Earl on the agenda representing County Waste, LLC.

Jonas Kreitzer gave a copy of the consent assignment between County Waste and Gittens Disposal. A copy will be sent to Attorney Aregood for review.

Mr. Kreitzer stated County Waste is willing to provide trash and recycling containers for Borough residents. A standard refuse container would be 95 gallons and a standard recyclable container would be 55 gallons. Refuse and recyclable pick-up days would remain the same.

OLD BUSINESS: The "Dog Ordinance" which was discussed in previous work sessions and council meetings was recently advertised in The Citizens' Voice Newspaper.

A motion to adopt the "Dog Ordinance" as advertised, was made by Larry Carbohn, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.

Rick Kratz requested that municipal advertisement be put in the local newspapers regarding the current Borough yard waste pick-up schedule. Secretary/Treasurer Tom Kneidinger stated that he would place the advertisement in the newspapers.

NEW BUSINESS: Larry Carbohn stated that the 2007 GMC white truck needs to have repairs to the dump hinge assembly. Larry Carbohn explained various repair options to council. The conclusion was that the repairs should not exceed \$1,000.00. A motion was made by Larry Carbohn to make repairs on the white truck, not to exceed \$1,000.00, seconded by Sandra Wegrzynowicz, and passed by 5 yes.

A motion was made by Larry Carbohn to hire Alex Harvey and James Tyler McCabe, part-time for the road crew, seconded by Sandra Wegrzynowicz, and passed by 5 yes. Alex Harvey would be paid at the rate of \$9.00/hr.

Larry Carbohn stated that the annual Borough tire pick-up will take place on Saturday, 06/10/2017.

There was a brief discussion of repair to the nets on the basketball court. Rick Kratz stated he would take care of this situation.

There was a brief discussion of repair to potholes in the Borough. It was concluded that action would be taken to remedy the situation.

Luke Matthews stated he would contract Paul Pasonick of PennEastern Engineering regarding the feasibility and cost for some proposed projects funded by The Community Development Program.

ATTORNEY AREGOOD'S REPORT: Attorney Aregood was absent.

POLICE REPORT: The Hanover Township Police Report for the month ending on 04/30/2017 was read by the Mayor. There were 16 calls with 9.0 man hours expended to handle these calls. These hours do not include time spent patrolling the Borough.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor gave a summary of a letter dated 05/05/2017 from The Luzerne County Board of Elections. The letter referred to the preparations and procedures for the upcoming Primary Election Day of 05/16/2017.

A motion to accept the Police Report and the Mayor's Report was made by Larry Carbohn, seconded by Rick Kratz, and passed by 5 yes.

PUBLIC COMMENT: A resident reminded Council of a potential Borough project to do street repairs on Boyle Street.
