

BOROUGH OF WARRIOR RUN

ORDINANCE 1990-4

REGULATION THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES, SNOW MOBILES,
MOTORCYCLES, ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES, OR MINI BIKES,
ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained
and enacted by the members of Council of the Borough of
Warrior Run, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania:

Section 101:

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a
vehicle, snowmobile, motorcycle, all terrain vehicle, or
mini bike, under the following circumstances:

(a) On private property of another without the express
permission to do so by the owner or occupant of said
property;

(b) On public school grounds, park property,
playgrounds, recreation areas, and property owned by Warrior
Run Borough without express provision or permission to do so
by the proper public authority;

(c) In a manner so as to create loud, unnecessary or
unusual noise so as to disturb or interfere with the peace
and quiet of other persons;

(d) In a careless, reckless or negligent manner so as
to endanger the safety of any person or the property of any
other person.

Section 102:

Notwithstanding the prohibitions of this Ordinance, the Parks and Recreation Director or a Committee Chairman of Borough shall have authority to supervise and regulate events or programs in connection with the events conducted by the Parks and Recreation Department in which vehicles, snowmobiles, motorcycles, all terrain vehicle, or mini bikes, are used. The Parks and Recreation Director or Committee Chairman of the Borough shall have the authority to designate Borough Park areas that he shall deem available for such use.

Section 103:

Violations and Penalties

Any operator of a vehicle, snowmobile, motorcycle, all terrain vehicle, or mini bike, who violates this Ordinance, on conviction thereof, may be punished by a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars and costs of such proceeding, and upon default of payment of such fine and costs, by imprisonment in the County prison for not more than thirty (30) days.

Section 104:

Definitions

For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

(a) Vehicle - Every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a

highway, except devices used exclusively upon rails or tracks.


(b) Snowmobile - A self-propelled vehicle designed for travel on snow or ice in a natural terrain steered by wheels, skis, or runners.

(c) Motorcycle - A motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground.

(d) All terrain vehicle - A vehicle which is self-propelled having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider having three or four wheels.

(e) Mini bike - A two wheeled vehicle which is self-propelled which does not qualify as a vehicle but which has a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and is designed to travel on not more than two wheels in contact with the ground.


